CONTEST RULES

1. Contest is open to anyone holding a Maine Fishing License.
2. Competition limited to fish taken in Maine in accordance with the fishing laws of the State.
3. Fish taken from a state, club or private hatchery or pool will not be eligible.
4. Weight of fish should be checked by a game warden or fisheries biologist when possible. In remote areas, fish may be weighed, certified by two disinterested persons and shown to a warden at angler's convenience. Even when fish is dressed or frozen, angler's application must bear a warden's signature. The warden will be the final judge of weight of fish before it was cleaned.

Minimum weights are:

Muskellunge 15 lbs.
Crappie 2 lbs.
Landlocked salmon 6 lbs.
Brown trout 6 lbs.
Rainbow trout 5 lbs.
Eastern brook trout 4 lbs.
Blueback-Sunapee trout 2 lbs.
Whitefish 4 lbs.

Splake 4 lbs.
Cusk 15 lbs.
Northern Pike 15 lbs.
Largemouth Bass 7 lbs.
Smallmouth Bass 5 lbs.
Pickerel 4 lbs.
Lake trout (togue) 15 lbs.
Atlantic sea-run salmon 15 lbs.
White perch 1 1/2 lbs.

Only one patch per species during any calendar year.
