THE ONE THAT DIDN'T GET AWAY CLUB RULES

- 1. Open to anyone holding a Maine Fishing License.
2. Competition limited to fish taken in Maine in accordance with the fishing laws of the State.
3. Fish taken from a state, club or private hatchery or pool will not be eligible.
4. Weight of fish should be checked by a game warden or fisheries biologist when possible. In remote areas, fish may be weighed, certified by two disinterested persons and shown to a warden at angler's convenience Even when fish is dressed or frozen, angler's application must bear a warden's signature. The warden will be the final judge of weight of fish before it was cleaned.

Minimum weights are:

Table with 3 columns listing fish species and their minimum weights: Blueback-Sunapee Trout (2 lbs), Bluegill (0.50 lb), Brown Trout (6 lbs), Common Carp (12 lbs), Crappie (2 lbs), Cusk (15 lbs), Eastern Brook Trout (4 lbs), Fallfish (2 lbs), Lake Trout (Togue) (15 lbs), Landlocked Salmon (6 lbs), Largemouth Bass (7 lbs), Muskellunge (20 lbs), Northern Pike (15 lbs), Pickerel (4 lbs), Pumpkinseed (0.50 lb), Rainbow Trout (5 lbs), Smallmouth Bass (5 lbs), Splake (4 lbs), Walleye (4 lbs), White Catfish (4 lbs), Whitefish (4 lbs), White Perch (1.5 lbs), Yellow Perch (1 lb).

Only one patch per species during any calendar year.
