



Art & Photography Contest Rules

March 27, 28 & 29, 2020

Entry Form

The **ENTRY FORM** will need to be downloaded from the State of Maine Sportsman's Show website and completed when submitted with artwork and/or photos on drop-off dates.

Drop-off Location:

Augusta Civic Center in the Howard/Arnold Room, North Wing, first floor
(please follow the signs, the location is different from last year)

Entries will be accepted on:

Wednesday, March 25, 2020 from 4:00pm-7:00pm

Thursday, March 26, 2020 from 12:00pm-6:00pm

NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED Friday, March 27th, 2020.

Participants must drop off artwork at the show and will receive a receipt listing all works submitted, and a receipt will be needed to pick up submissions.

Work must be prepared and ready to hang by hook or wire.

PLEASE HOLD ON TO YOUR RECEIPT.

FEE

There is a fee of \$3 per entry due upon drop off, please make checks payable to **State of Maine Sportsman's Show (SMSS)** with submissions. Credit Cards are accepted.

PICK UP

Entries may be picked up on Sunday, March 29th, between 2:30pm and 4:00pm. **Please present your receipt.** All entries not retrieved by 4:00pm will be taken to The Maine Sportsman. We are not responsible for packages damaged during transfer to The Maine Sportsman after show closes.

SALE OF ENTRIES

Entries may be sold at owner's discretion. All participants have the right to assign a sale price to any submission. No commission will be charged for works sold at or as a result of the show. Management will promote and encourage art and photography purchase. We simply act as an agent to get potential buyers in contact with the artist or photographer.

ART

There are seven different categories that will be judged:

- Oil
- Acrylic
- Watercolor
- Pastel
- Mixed Media (pen and ink, pencil, etc.)
- 3D & Art Carvings
- Woodburning, must not exceed 2'x3'

Art Specified Rules and Requirements:

- No art previously displayed in the show will be accepted
- All work submitted must depict fish, wildlife and landscape from North America
- 2D art must not exceed 3' x 3' in size
- No furniture
- Work must be prepared and ready to hang by hook or wire.

PHOTOGRAPHY

The photography portion will be judged in different categories below:

- People in Outdoors Activities
- Landscapes and Scenery
- Macro Photography (color photos only, please)
- Manipulated/Altered or Enhanced
- Wildlife: Fish, Mammals and all other living creatures
- Birds (song birds, birds of prey, waterfowl, etc.)

Photography specific rules and requirements:

- No photos previously displayed in the show will be accepted
- Work must be prepared and ready to hang by hook or wire.

CLASSES OF EXHIBITS

Each artist or photographer is to enter their works in one of 3 classes:

- Novice
Worked in medium off and on for 2 years or less
100 or less pieces
- Intermediate
Worked in medium 2 or more years

Returned to medium after several years away
Exhibit and sell work in galleries and/or shows/fairs

- Professional

Working in medium for several years

Working in medium mostly full time

Exhibit and sell working galleries and/or shows/fairs

Has had a personal art exhibit

Each artist is able to submit works in different categories, **participants can only submit 3 per category**. Each class (novice, intermediate, professional) will be judged separately.

JUDGING AND AWARDS

Entries will be judged on **Friday, March 27th, at 10:00am**. At that time, the Art & Photography room will be closed until 1:00pm, or when judging is finished.

1st, 2nd, and 3rd ribbons will be awarded in each category for both the Art Show and Photography Show and will be awarded a ribbon.

One entry from each class of Art and Photography will receive **BEST IN SHOW** and will be awarded a ribbon and recognition in the May issue of *The Maine Sportsman Magazine* and the *SAM News* and on the Show Facebook page.

Show attendees will view all artwork and vote by ballot for **PEOPLE'S CHOICE AWARD** for both Art and Photography. The ballots will be tallied on Sunday, March 29th at noon. The winners of the *People's Choice Award* will be contacted and will receive a ribbon and recognition in the May issue of *The Maine Sportsman* and the *SAM NEWS*.

DISCLAIMER

Show staff will be assigned to the display area during show hours. Reasonable precautions will be taken to protect submissions from damage or loss, however, we cannot assume responsibility if damage occurs. Entries are left at the show at the owner's risk. The exhibit room is locked each night.

Receipts will be given for all work submitted. The receipt will note that while all works will be given all possible protection, they will not be insured and the show management assumes no liability in displaying or judging them.
