RULES

1. Open to anyone, resident and non-resident, holding a Maine hunting license.
2. Limited to deer of the Whitetail species and taken only in Maine in accordance with game laws.
3. No animal known to have been shot by anyone other than applicant him/herself will qualify.
4. The deer, bear and moose must be legally harvested and tagged in the state of Maine, regardless of where the hunter is from.
5. Tagging station attendants, Maine game wardens and state game biologists can certify weight. If possible, please have witnesses also. If applying for a Maine state record scales must be officially calibrated.
6. A shoulder patch and packet will be awarded to qualifying members.
