1. The moose must be legally harvested and tagged in the state of Maine, regardless of where the hunter is from.

2. Only the permittee or sub-permittee that harvested and registered the moose is allowed to apply.

- 3. One shoulder patch and club card is issued per moose harvested, per year.
- 4. The following officials can certify the dressed weight of the moose: Tagging station attendants, Maine game wardens and state game biologists. If applying for a Maine state record scales must be officially calibrated.
- 5. A shoulder patch and packet will be awarded to qualifying members.
