RULES

1. The turkey must be legally harvested and tagged in the state of Maine, regardless of where the hunter is from.
2. One shoulder patch and club packet is issued per turkey harvested, per year.
3. The following officials can certify the dressed weight of the turkey: Tagging station attendants, Maine game wardens and state game biologists. If applying for a Maine state record scales must be officially calibrated.
4. A shoulder patch and packet will be awarded to qualifying members.
